ALERT: LIFECYCLE WEEK, CAPE ARGUS CYCLE TOUR AND EASTER LONG WEEKEND RELATED ACTIVITY AND FILM OFFICE HOURS

The City of Cape Town Film Permitting Office would like to advise on limitations on film-related activity in the City for the periods below. These restrictions are informed by the Events Management (including Traffic Management Plans) and safety and security matters associated with these high-profile City and regional events.

1. Life Cycle Week 3-8 March 2008

- Limited availability of Traffic Officers in "Northern" Cape Town area – Bellville, Blaauwberg, Kraaifontein, Strand due to Giro del Capo.
- March 8th: 06h30 – 10h00– No filming in and around Kloof Nek Road and Signal Hill - Giro del Capo Final Stage.

2. Pick 'n Pay Argus Cycle Tour - Proudly hosted by the City of Cape Town – 9 March 2008

Note: No film-related activity:

- Saturday, 8th March: 14h00 onward - CBD- Foreshore (near Civic Centre), Green Point (Beach Road to Green Point Circle)
- Sunday, 9th March -04h00 – 18h30: CBD - Foreshore, Eastern Boulevard, N2/M3, Cape Argus Route around the Peninsula to end point at Green Point Stadium (See attached route)

NB: Roads will be reopened in stages by Traffic Dept.

Please ensure that all applications for permits for the week following the long weekends are submitted well in advance.


5. April/May Public Holidays 27-28th April, 1st May
